Visual aid guidelines (40 points)

Must incorporate some form of technology.

Must be colorful, attractive and eye-catching.

Must be readable (spelling, print size, color)

Must contain important, accurate information.

Your group is responsible for a bibliography containing no less than three (3) sources.
